1st Race- Small Pony Flat Race

For small ponies (under 12.2 hands). About 2 furlongs on the dirt.

2nd Race- Pony Lead Line Trot Race

For ponies ridden by juniors, who have not reached their 7th birthday as of the 1st of the year. Ponies must have lead line attached to their bridle and must be accompanied by an adult. About 1 furlong on the dirt. Walk or trot; entries breaking out of the trot must pull up immediately and resume trotting, excessive breaking will result in DQ. Riders must wear ASTM approved helmets. Overgirths & protective vests are highly encouraged. Racing silks encouraged. May be split into two divisions if entries warrant.

3rd Race- Large Pony Flat Race

For large ponies (over 13.2h, but not exceeding 14.2h). About 2-3 furlongs on the dirt.

4th Race Medium Pony Flat Race

For medium ponies (12.2h -13.2h), About 2 furlongs on the dirt.

5th Race- Shetland Pony Flat Race

Restricted to Shetland Ponies, approx. 1 1/2 furlongs on the dirt. Rider must be size appropriate for mount.

All riders are to not have had their 16th birthday as of January 1st, except where noted. All trainers must be 18+ years old.

Ponies may be measured race day to ensure proper division placement. Lead Line ponies may be used in one lat race, all other flat race ponies may only be used once. All race entries (rider and pony) MUST be approved by the committee before being allowed to run. Ponies who have started in the last year under Jockey Club rules are prohibited.

Entry Fee: \$30, late scratch fee applies. Entry fee must be paid upon entering. PayPal, credit card, or check. Proof of rider health insurance, negative coggins, signed release forms, health certificate, approved helmet, yoke/neckstrap, overgirth and protective vest are required.
