# Howard County Cup Pony Races

Pleasant Prospect Farm Sunday, Oct 16, 2022

## **Leadline Trot Race**

For ponies at the walk and trot. No cantering, leader and spotter may not drag, push, strike, etc pony to increase speed. Riders are not eligible for any other race on the day.

Division I- riders 4 and under, may have a spotter on the far side of the pony

Division II- rider may not have had their 7th birthday as of January 1

#### **Shetland Pony Flat Race**

For Shetland ponies to be ridden by junior riders who have not had their 16th birthday as of the first of the year. About 2 furlongs on the turf.

## **Small Pony Flat Race**

For small ponies (under 12.2 hands) to be ridden by junior riders who have not had their 16th birthday as of the first of the year. About 2 furlongs on the turf.

## **Medium Pony Flat Race**

For medium ponies (12.2h -13.2h), to be ridden by junior riders who have not had their 16th birthday as of the first of the year. About 2 ½ furlongs on the dirt.

# Large Pony Flat Race

For large ponies (over 13.2h, but not exceeding 14.2h) to be ridden by junior riders who have not had their 16th birthday as of the first of the year. About 4 furlongs on the tur.

Ponies may be measured race day to ensure proper division placement. Leadline ponies may be used in one flat race. All race entries (rider and pony) MUST be approved by the committee before being allowed to run. Ponies who have started in the last year under Jockey Club rules are prohibited. Riders who have race ridden in open company at the Pt-to-Pt or Sanctioned levels are prohibited.

Entry Fee: \$30, late scratch fee applies. Entry fee must be paid with entry. No exceptions. PayPal, venmo, credit card, or check. Proof of rider health insurance, negative coggins, signed release forms, approved helmet, overgirth and protective vest are required. Races may be combined, canceled, or split.
