It is the trainers' responsibility to review the overnight and make changes by 11:00 am, the Wednesday before the races with the Central Entry Office (540) 439-3848 or wfo1717@gmail.com.

All Riders must sign Waiver of Liability forms and must provide proof of insurance before being allowed to ride.

All people who plan to be on horseback must wear protective headgear. All race riders must wear protective vests.

All horses must be checked in with Pippy McCormick at the paddock one hour prior to their post time posted on this overnight, or they will be scratched. Violators of this rule may be subject to a fine by the Stewards. Race day scratches can be made with Pippy McCormick (540) 454-2854.

NO toe grabs, caulks, stickers, turndowns, inserts, trailers or heel extensions will be allowed on the front or hind shoes. Note: The insert on the toe of the Queen's Plate is considered a "wear plate," not a toe grab. Block heels on the hind shoes (not to exceed ¼ inch) are permissible. ONLY QUEEN'S PLATE FLAT, QUEEN'S PLATE WEDGE AND STEEL TRAINING PLATES OR THEIR EQUIVALENT MAY BE USED. OUTER RIMS ARE PERMITTED ONLY WITHOUT TOE GRABS.

Please check the information on this overnight. Any changes or corrections can be made prior to scratch time on Wednesday to make the program.

Entries must be paid before saddle cloths will be issued.

As required by the Virginia Department of Agriculture: "All horses must be accompanied by a report of an official negative test for equine infectious anemia (Coggins Test) conducted within the last 12 months. The Certificate must accompany all horses in order to gain access to the grounds. This requirement will be strictly enforced. A health certificate must accompany horses shipping from outside Virginia.

Directions to The Hill: From Culpeper take Rt. 522 towards Sperryville. Go approximately 7 miles to entrance on the left.
